

The Complete DS-260 Form Filing Guide

The DS-260 immigrant visa electronic application is one of the most vital documents for those seeking to reside in the United States. Essentially, this form acts as an immigrant's official background check and eligibility screening. All of the information presented is carefully reviewed by the U.S government to determine whether an applicant can lawfully enter and remain in the country.

Due to the importance and volume of information required to complete the application, working with clients as they navigate the DS-260 immigrant visa application form is a significant test for your firm. Often, jumbled documents and missing information must be transformed into an accurate application so your client can reach the immigration interview.

What is Form DS-260?

The [Immigrant Visa Electronic Application](#), Form DS-260, is part of the US permanent immigration process. It is filed outside the US and brings together the client's supporting proof ahead of the immigration interview.

Immigration attorneys sometimes see confusion between this and the DS-160 form, but the DS-160 form is used for temporary visitation only.

Recently, there have been [some changes to Form DS-260](#), including:

- Less explanatory information allowed
- The form is now locked post-submission
- All details must exactly match passport details
- DS-260 printable forms and paper copies are no longer allowed
- Submission is now a fully digital process

This new strictness makes your support even more critical.

What is the DS-260 Form Used For?

Post-petition, the National Visa Center (NVC) opens an immigration case. DS-260 then provides the information used to determine whether your client is eligible for an immigration visa. This means accuracy is a must, as changes cannot be easily made after submission.

What Does the DS-260 Form Look Like?

The DS-260 login, hosted on the [Consular Electronic Application Center \(CEAC\) portal](#), leads to a multi-page form. This will adjust its sections based on the visa type being applied for and what your client enters.

As it's both long and complex, the form itself can intimidate clients, and this is where your expertise will be invaluable.

How to Fill out the DS-260 Form

Clients should understand that the NVC serves as the bridge between USCIS petition approval and the final visa interview. When the petition is approved, NVC takes over the file, and that's when the Form DS-260 login occurs.

Step 1: Track Down All Relevant Information

Before filling in the USCIS form DS-260, your client will need a lot of information, including:

- Passport details
- Residential history
- Employment history
- Family member information
- Previous visa and immigration history
- Social media accounts used within the last five years
- Previous addresses, including the dates they lived at each address

They will also need supporting documents such as:

- The passport itself
- Birth certificates
- Police certificates from all countries lived in from age 16
- Form I-864 Affidavit of Support from your client's sponsor
- Two identical 2x2 passport photos
- And, if applicable:
 - Military records
 - Marriage and divorce/death certificates
 - Court/prison records

Gathering complete information at this stage makes for a smoother process.

Step 2: Log into CEAC and Begin Entering Your Client's Information

Your client's NVC welcome letter will include their case number and invoice ID for the [CEAC portal](#).

Now you're free to walk them through the necessary information. Everything must be accurate and align exactly with their documents.

Step 3: Upload All Requested Documents

Once supporting documents are uploaded, you can support your client by ensuring:

- Documents meet file size and format requirements
- Foreign-language documents are properly translated
- [Country-specific document requirements](#) are satisfied
- Uploaded copies are clear and legible

Who completes the DS-260 form?

The immigrant completes Form DS-260 with support from their immigration attorney.

What is the confirmation page from the Form DS-260?

The Form DS-260 confirmation page is a receipt from the Consular Electronic Application Center. Keep the page handy once it is generated, as it will be needed during the visa interview.

How can I edit my DS-260 form after submission?

Once submitted, the DS-260 form is locked. Ensure every prompt in the form is addressed completely and accurately before submitting, which may need the support of your immigration attorney.

How do I get a copy of my DS-260 form?

Applicants can print or download a copy from the CEAC portal after submission. The case number and invoice ID will be needed.

How long does it take to process the DS-260 form?

Form DS-260 processing times vary, but are usually around 1 to 3 months. Then there will be a wait for the interview, which can be significant.
